OUR STORY

Camp Boneyard was founded in December 2021 by Finley Nguyen as a virtual music festival live-streamed on Twitch, garnering thousands of viewers across the world. Finley was inspired by similar online events that had sprung out of the pandemic in the Hyperpop scene, such as Subculture Party's Zoom raves, Goop Fest, and Jane Remover's 'Camp Frailty.'

In November 2021, Finley founded underscord, the official Discord server for Hyperpop musician underscores, and home to Camp Boneyard. The community fosters up-and-coming underground creatives.

Camp Boneyard combines visual art and music with a narrative unique to each year to keep audiences engaged. Storytelling, artistry, and the DIY ethos is at the heart of its mission to support LGBTQ+ and diverse youth. The festival is fully volunteer led and raises money for charitable causes selected by the community.

ABOUT THE FOUNDER & DIRECTOR

Finley Nguyen is a sophomore at Macaulay Honors College at Hunter College, pursuing an interdisciplinary major in CUNY BA titled, "Developing Technologies in Music Administration," which explores the intersection of computer science, music, business, and design.

He founded Camp Boneyard in December 2021 as a virtual music festival that live-streams annually on Twitch, inspired by the rise of online events during the pandemic. Since then, the festival has fundraised over \$16,000 for non-profits including Doctors Without Borders, Rainbow Railroad, and Trans Lifeline. Camp Boneyard operates through volunteer coordinators, artists, and performers.

Finley is building a career in the live music industry by producing Camp Boneyard's first in-person festival at Stone Circle Theatre on April 25, 2026, funded by the CUNY BA Changemakers Grant. He started working in live music his freshman year, thanks to the CUNY Cultural Corps program, where he was placed as a Production Management Intern at Voices of Ascension. After the internship, Finley was hired to continue at Voices of Ascension as a Production Assistant. He also works as a Guest Services Associate at the Brooklyn Paramount music venue.

These experiences, made possible by CUNY, kickstarted Finley's journey in the music business, where he hopes to promote diversity and equity by advocating for underrepresented musicians.

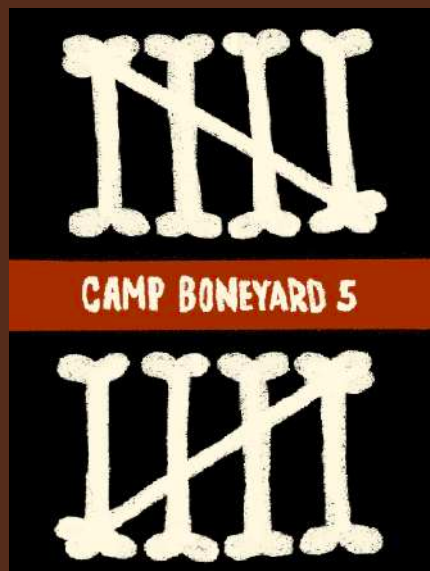
